

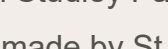

Moving through the levels

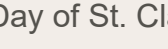


If you have been walking down Studley Park Road you may have noticed the incredible progress being made by St. Clare's construction workers. With two cranes operating, and the concrete structure for the ground floor slab nearing completion, we can see the buildings rise, already to Level 3 on Building D (Chestnut). Our heritage buildings will be covered in scaffolding for a while, before emerging again, beautifully restored. Behind the scenes, services are being fitted out, with tradespeople starting to install functional aspects such as permanent lighting.

St. Clare of Assisi Feast Day

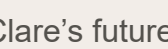


Sunday August 11 is the Feast Day of St. Clare. Born into nobility in Assisi in 1193, St. Clare manifested a tender love towards the poor from an early age. At 18, she left home against her family's wishes to become a follower of St. Francis and live in a Benedictine convent, becoming a superior at 22. She inspired many young women to follow her path, founding the Order of the Poor Ladies, who were devoted to prayer, penance, and contemplation.

Living in austere conditions, they supported themselves by their own labour, dwelling in hospices. This aligns with VMCH's mission - creating genuine places of belonging, through service and compassion for all aged, disadvantaged and people with disability. At St. Clare Kew we will light a candle on Monday 12 August, to commemorate her Feast Day.
